Information we collect about you

We collect nonpublic personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications and other forms
- information about you transactions with us

We may disclose all of the information we collect, as described above, as permitted by law.

Parties who receive information from us

We may disclose nonpublic personal information about to the following types of third parties:

- **Financial service providers**, such as mortgage service companies
- **Non-financial companies**, such as consumer reporting agencies, and government agencies.

Disclosure of information about former members

If you terminate your membership with Desert Sage FCU , we will not share information we have collected about you, except as may be permitted or required by law.

How we protect your information

We restrict access to nonpublic, personal information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, or procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to guard your nonpublic information.
